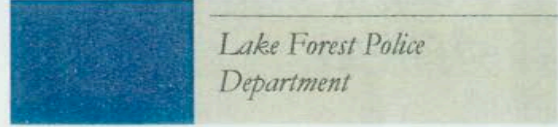

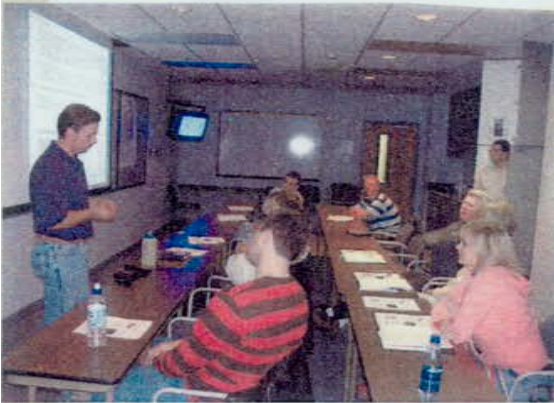

Citizens Police Academy



The Citizens Police Academy is a ten week class designed to enhance communication between the department and the community.

Students are instructed in a variety of law enforcement topics by officers who specialize in those areas. In addition, participants have the option of riding with an officer on patrol and firing department pistols on our indoor range.

Class Sessions

Classes are held Wednesday evenings from 7 to 10 PM in the police station classroom. The ten week sessions are offered in the fall. Classes are kept small to facilitate discussion.

There is no charge to enroll.

Who Can Attend

The Citizens Police Academy is open to anyone who:

- Is 21 years of age
- Lives or works in Lake Forest
- Has no criminal record

A criminal background check is completed on all applicants. The Lake Forest Police Department reserves the right to deny enrollment to applicants with a criminal history.
