HOW TO START A YOUTH POLICE ACADEMY

and

TEACHING YOUR COMMUNITY ABOUT GANGS

WHY ATTEND?

Law enforcement agencies use a variety of methods to build relationships with the community. One program is the Youth Police Academy, which is patterned after the popular Citizen Police Academy. A Youth Police Academy introduces youth to functions and activities in a law enforcement agency. A Youth Police Academy provides police departments and sheriff's offices with the opportunity to describe law enforcement the way it really is... not the television version, but their own local, real-life version of how they go about doing their job. It provides an opportunity for youth to better understand police work, and is another mechanism for law enforcement agencies to inform the public, and obtain citizen input, assistance and support by sharing information. A Youth Police Academy can provide stronger citizen-police relationships, enhance lines of communication, reduce crime, and get youth interested in law enforcement or other related career field.

In addition, teaching police officers, CPA, YPA, school staff, community groups, and your elected officials about street gangs can be a difficult situation. Each group involves using a different approach, information, and teaching style. Learn how to use the right method and style for each type of group to keep the message clear and stay away from potentially negative situations. We will review these methods while going through an example street gang presentation.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

This training seminar is designed to help law enforcement officers and administrators that are interested in starting up a Youth Police Academy program in their community, as well as officers that currently coordinate and/or instruct classes for their agency's Citizen Police Academy. The presentation on gangs will assist any agency that wants to inform and answer questions from various community groups, and will offer different techniques to do so based on each community or group's needs. **Attendees will learn:**

- How to START a Youth Police Academy, including how to get departmental and community support, budgetary considerations, choosing a coordinator and instructors, curriculum selection, and evaluation.
- The BENEFITS associated with hosting a Youth Police Academy program.
- New IDEAS/TOPICS for making your Youth Police Academy classes educational, entertaining, and memorable... from day one to graduation.
- How and what to TEACH your community about gangs.
- Taking a different APPROACH for each community, as well as each group within that community.

ABOUT THE SPEAKER

Officer John Abbio has been in law enforcement since 1997. He is currently assigned to the Crime Prevention Unit of the Wheeling Police Department, and is the current coordinator of the Youth Police Academy. Some of Officer Abbio's other specialties include: Juvenile officer, Gang officer, Firearms instructor, Armorer, Wheeling SWAT operator, Translator, and Crime Free Multi-Housing officer. Officer Abbio has hosted several successful Youth Police Academies, has been involved in numerous gang violence cases, has performed countless hours of undercover work, and has testified as an expert witness in several gang cases.

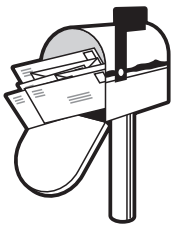

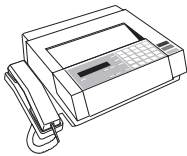
